Reviewing Progress

We will review the child's progress every half term to ensure that he/she is benefitting from the Flexi-School arrangement. If the child's progress is not at the level we are expecting for that child, we will meet with parents/carers to plan how the child can improve. If after an intervention the child's progress is not improving, we will then withdraw the Flexi-School arrangement and expect the child to attend school full time until they are back on track. We can return to Flexi-schooling in the future if all parties are in agreement that this will benefit the child's education.

I understand that if my child is not progressing as expected, I will need to meet with the school to discuss possible solutions. If, after trying agreed interventions my child's progress is still not improving, I understand that the Flexi-School arrangement may be withdrawn until they are back on track.
