Whole school visit to Thorpe Market Church

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that the whole school will be going on a trip to **Thorpe Market Church** on **Wednesday 25th March 2026**.

This visit will support and enrich our religious education learning for the **Spring term**. Reverend Sian Reading has been coming to the school for a few months to deliver some assemblies and has arranged this visit to enable a more practical learning experience around Easter.

During our visit, the children will have a talk about Palm Sunday. There will be some palm crosses for the children and then they will have a short "procession" into Church where they will have a run through aspects of Holy Week starting with Jesus driving out the money changers in the Temple, through foot washing and the Last Supper and then the arrest and crucifixion, and ending with a short bit about Easter Sunday.

We will be leaving school at **9.45am** and will return before lunch. We will be travelling by minibus and my car completing a few trips to get all of the children there. I hold full business insurance and appropriate booster seats will be provided if required. If you are happy for your child to be transported by myself, please **inform Mrs Flatman or myself**.

There is no cost to you for this trip, the transport costs have been covered from a donation the school received from Judith Bartram Trust. We are looking forward to what should be a brilliant morning out for all.
