

## Autumn Once Upon a time.



In maths we will be looking at sorting objects and counting to 5 and then 10. We will be practising our number formation and our counting skills. We will use number songs and rhymes to learn all about number and the order they go in, we will then begin to combine two number, firstly practically and then we will record them.



In English we will be beginning our learning with the text Peace on Earth, we will use this story to make a shop, to label the items and write description.

We will also get to write character description.

We will then be reading the text Sidney, Stella and the Moon Emma Yarlett, in this text we will write fact files about the moon 'Lost' posters, labels, glossaries

In the Once Upon a Time project, your child will be introduced to the wonderful world of stories. They will listen to a range of traditional tales and have the chance to act out the stories in their play. They will also listen to alternative contemporary stories to see different viewpoints from the characters. They will use the stories to think about how life has changed from when the stories were written. They will also make up their own stories and make masks, props and puppets to act out their stories
